RESULTS OF APSCUF ELECTION

Held: Wednesday, March 11 and Thursday, March 12, 2009

Runoff elections will be held from Wednesday, March 18 at 8:30 AM to Thursday, March 19, 2009 at 4:00 PM.

The number of votes received by each candidate is shown below; 185 members voted (180 faculty and 5 coaches). An asterisk (*) indicates that the candidate was elected. Runoffs are required when too few candidates receive a “majority” of the votes cast, as defined in the APSCUF bylaws. (The number of votes needed to constitute a majority is shown for each committee.) The letter R indicates that the candidate will be involved in a runoff election. Unelected candidates receiving fewer than 10 write-in votes are not shown.
