Failure to do so will cause a significant negative impact."

Wilma notes that her APSCUF service has produced a lot of fun times that she will forever cherish, but she noted there is a responsibility when you're an APSCUF leader.

"People are often aware of the events on their respective campuses, but it's important that campus leaders make everyone aware of what's going on statewide. Our State Staff monitors the PASSHE in Harrisburg for us."
